

iCloud: On both phones, go to Settings > [Your name] > iCloud. Slide Contacts to On position. If opted, merge contacts to avoid losing any.Backup: On old phone, turn on iCloud Backup. Choose Back Up Now. On new phone, go to Apps & Data > Restore from iCloud Backup.iTunes: Connect old phone to computer/iTunes. Go to Backups > This Computer > Back Up Now. On new phone, choose Restore Backup. In this guide, we detail five ways to transfer contacts between iPhones: via iCloud, an iCloud backup, iTunes, web-based tools, and third-party software. Instructions in this article apply to iPhones with iOS 9 and up. The easiest methods to transfer contacts use features that come with the iPhone, such as iCloud. Since iCloud can keep data synchronized across all your devices, using it to sync contacts from iPhone to iPhone makes it an easy choice. Ensure that both iPhones are signed in with the same Apple ID and are connected to Wi-Fi. On both phones, open Settings, tap your name, then tap iCloud. Move the Contacts slider to on/green. This step will upload your contacts to iCloud if they're not already there. If lots of contacts need to be backed up, it might take a while to finish. If a message appears about merging the contacts, choose that option so that none of the contacts are deleted. Because data from both phones first uploads to iCloud and then syncs to both phones, you have to sync all of your contacts to both devices.
